## Welcome to New & Continuing Members

We hope the information here will help you enjoy your golf and develop and maintain friendships with other members.

Membership entitles you to play on our course as many times a week as you would like respecting that if you choose not to play in a competition those who are have right of way. The practice fairway, practice green and driving net are available for your use.

Competition times and fees are as follows:- (Note: Tuesday twilight is a 9-hole competition, Friday night is a 9-Hole Ambrose and Thursday a 9-hole competition is available, all others are 18 holes)

Sunday (mixed) 8.00am - 9am, 11.30am - 12.30pm - \$10 Monday (mixed, seniors, once a month) 9.30am registration, 10am hit off - \$10

Public Holidays (mixed) 8am - 9 am, 11.30am - 12.30pm - \$10

Tuesday (mixed) 9 holes, twilight during daylight saving 4.30pm - 6pm - \$5 (visitors \$5 + \$5 green fee)

Wednesday (men) 8am - 9am, 11am - 1.00pm - \$10

Thursday (women) Summer - 7.30am - 8.30am Winter - 7.30am for 9am

Friday - 9 - hole Ambrose during daylight saving, 4pm - 6pm - \$5

<u>Saturday</u> (mixed) 1<sup>st</sup> tee 7.45am - 9.30am, 11.30am - 1.07pm 10<sup>th</sup> tee 7.45am - 9.30am, 11.30am - 1.07pm - \$10

#### If you hit outside these times you <u>DO NOT</u> have right of way.

<u>Visitors who have reciprocal rights</u> pay the same competition fees as members. For <u>visitors without reciprocal rights</u> payment of green fees (\$30) plus competition fees entitles them to enter the competition.

#### To enter a competition

- enter via Simple Golf App in advance or before the time you want to hit off by following instructions on either touch screen in Sprig bar.
  Your printed card will show - name, date, daily handicap and type of competition.
- place competition fee in envelope (found past the doorway, along from the printer), mark clearly with your name and place in the slot marked 'Competition fees' or pay via EFTPOS of from Prize Wallet at the bar & place receipt for this in slot marked 'Competition Fees'
- all complaints or suggestions must be placed before the committee in writing for consideration.

- watch the noticeboard for alterations and additions to local rules

 $(\mathbf{A})$ 

- the Match Committee reserves the right to alter the programme or method of play at any time
- subscriptions are due by 31<sup>st</sup> March. Only financial members are eligible to play in club competitions
- in each group the player with the lowest handicap is responsible for etiquette and the pace of play
- groups of 5 are ONLY permitted in the LAST group of the day. Simple Golf will not allow more than 5 players at the one time - to use phone to score, players must be registered at the same playing time.

#### At the end of the competition

- if using card make sure your card has your name & handicap on it, is signed by you and the marker and is correct or if using phone to score - ensure you have signed - score will NOT upload unless this is done.
- If using card to score follow instructions on either touch screen in Sprig bar to enter scores. If using phone score will automatically upload.
- place the card in the slot box provided (between two touch screens).

## Port Lincoln Golf Club Local Rules as at January 2024

- 1. Out of Bounds A ball lying beyond the perimeter fence or in the car park is Out of Bounds.
- Penalty Area The Dam bordered by the 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes is a penalty area, and is defined by red stakes. Relief may be taken under Rule 17.1

#### 3. No Play Zones

**Penalty Area** - The area within the red penalty area bordered by the 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes defined by brown posts with linked white rope is a No Play Zone. When a ball is in a No Play Zone within the penalty area, the ball must not be played as it lies, and relief must be taken from interference by the No Play Zone under Rule 17.1e. Entry to this area is prohibited.

Solar Panel Area - The area defined by blue and black stakes, right hand side of the 14<sup>th</sup> fairway is a NO play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition, Free relief must be taken from interference by the NO play zone under rule 16.1 F.

- Staked Trees Staked trees identified by white stakes or less than 2 club-lengths in height are No Play Zones and are Ground Under Repair. Relief must be taken under Rule 16.1f
- 5. Preferred Lies If a ball comes to rest on the fairway or the fairway marker of the hole being played, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball within one club grip length of the spot of the original ball. The relief area must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area. The fairway markers are the outer mowed edges and/or the dye spots. If that is not discernible then the ball must be played as it lies.

#### 6. Abnormal Course Conditions (Including Immovable Obstructions) - Rule 16

a. Exposed rocks in the general Area

b. Roads and marks made by an implement or a vehicle (other than a golf cart)

c. Rough or pitted areas on any putting green – Relief may be taken as per Rule 16.1d

 Suspension of Play for Dangerous Situation - will be signalled by activation of the siren. All play must immediately cease - Rule 5.7b(1)

Penalty for Breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty (stroke play - two strokes, match play - loss of hole)



# **Terms of the Competition**

8

- 1. Golf Carts may be used in all club competitions BUT are not allowed within 10m of greens and 5m of tees where possible.
- Play Offs Competitors required for play offs in championship events must be in the clubhouse when the last cards are presented to the match committee otherwise that competitor will be deemed to have forfeited the right to be involved in the playoff. Playoff holes to be 1<sup>st</sup> for Women's & 9<sup>th</sup> for Men. Sudden death format to apply
- 3. Groups Players must play within the times established by the committee. Playing groups to be no larger than 4 players, unless at end of field where maximum of 5 players. Simple Golf will only allow a maximum of 4 players in each time slot. To use phone to score players need to be registered in the same time slot.
- Tee Off Times Players to be present at least 5 minutes prior to nominated starting time and must hit off on time and play all holes in sequence.
- 5. Financial Prior to commencing play, players must be financial, enter the competition by registering in the competition on the computer and by placing the competition fee in the envelope with name and place it in the fee's receptacle. In the event of computer malfunction blank scorecards are available and should be used. Failure to comply with any of these requirements may render the player ineligible and to be disqualified.
- Visitors Visitors from reciprocal and other clubs may enter the competitions but will not be eligible to win major prizes or trophies (Open days & Special Events excepted). A suitable alternative trophy will be provided to winning visitors.
- 7. Country Members Country members are not eligible to win closed club events.
- 8. **Disputes** All disputes shall be resolved by the Match Committee members present on the day.

# Men's Grades

## Forms of Play

**MATCH:** The game is played by holes. A hole is won by the player who holes his ball in the fewest strokes. A match is won by the player who is leading by a number of holes greater than the number of holes remaining to be played. In a handicap match, the lower handicapper reverts to scratch and his opponent receives the number of strokes equal to the difference in handicaps. These strokes are allocated to holes as shown on the index on the scorecard, and the lower nett score wins the hole.

**FOURSOME:** Played with a partner using one ball. The partners play alternately from the teeing grounds and alternately during the play of each hole. Penalty strokes do not affect the order of play. In handicap match play, take strokes according to the difference in handicaps and if a half stroke occurs, round upwards to the next whole number.

**CANADIAN FOURSOME:** Played as a Foursome, except that both partners tee off on each hole, then select the preferred ball to be played.

**<u>PINEHURST</u>**: Played as a Canadian Foursome except that, on each hole, each player hits his second shot with his partner's ball, before selecting the preferred ball.

McKENZIE FOURSOME: Played as a Canadian Foursome except that on each hole, each player hits his second shot with his own ball, before selecting the preferred ball.

**FOURBALL:** Two competitors play as partners, each playing his own ball. The better score of the partners is the score for the hole.

**AMBROSE:** A team event. All tee off then the preferred ball is chosen. Move other balls to that spot then all hit again. Continue like this until holed out. Balls of other team members must be dropped within one club length, not nearer the hole, of where the preferred ball lay, except on the green where all balls are placed on the exact spot.






